MONDAY, 20th December, 2021

Morning session, 9.00 - 13.00

The official opening of the meeting was held at Technological University of Tajikistan, which was officially opened by the Vice-Rector of International Relations Department, Professor Khayol Boboev. He welcomed the audience and spoke about the importance and significant contribution of the project into the development of engineering education in Tajikistan, opportunities and achievements of the project. He also emphasized the fact that such a wide range of opportunities for scientific and educational cooperation and exchange of experience is very useful and effective.

Then, the Project Coordinator Elisabeth Lazarou from the University Politechnica of Bucharest (Romania) made an opening speech and spoke about the active participation of partners in achieving the goals and objectives of the project and the level and quality of work performed, thus creating a favorable working environment for the event.

In this regard, in connection with the work program of the meeting, Elisabeth Lazarou set the following tasks for the participants to review and analyze some of the work done:

- project outcome: finalization of the project outcomes in WP 1,2 3, 4 and 5:
- sustainability strategy for the EXTEND centers: updated business plan and action plan;
- financial management: financial statements, check and modification of financial documents for the financial audit in January 2022;
- further possibilities of cooperation between the project partners;
- proposal for a spin-off CBHE project for further development of the EXTEND centers. Application deadline: 7th of February 2022.

Afternoon session, 14.00 - 18.00

Working groups continued their work on Deliverable outcomes. Participants discussed the urgent issues and shared the missing information with each other. At the end of the day the draft results of working groups were presented and discussed.

TUESDAY, 21st December, 2021

Morning session, 9.00 - 13.00

The second day of the meeting took place in TNU. The day started with a welcome speech of Safargul Odinazoda, Director of EXTEND Centre of Tajik National University. Odinazoda Safargul, Director of the EXTENDED Center of the TNU, welcomed the participants and noted that the project is very important for the development of engineering education at TNU. This project was able to create a solid foundation for future cooperation and launch joint scientific and training projects. The working groups presented their reports one-by-one for general discussion.

The Project Coordinator Elisabeth Lazarou recapped the previous day and presented the plan for finalizing the missing outcomes. All participants continued their work on different tasks in working groups with focus on the deliverables project outcomes, the dissemination activities and the website content.

In parallel, the Project Coordinator started monitoring the financial statements. In the process of financial monitoring the necessary changes were made.

Afternoon session, 14.00 – 18.00

Olga Ivanova (BMSTU) made a presentation on the Course Book, in which she spoke about chapters and subchapters of the Book, the revisions that should be urgently made and the date of its issue in the central Russian Publishing House. It was discussed that Tajik universities will publish their Course Materials in the local Publishing House.

Then representatives of Partner universities made presentations about their EXTEND Centres (goals, objectives, purchased equipment, the conducted events, etc.). They also presented the business and sustainability plans of EXTEND Centres and highlighted what they will develop after the Project lifetime. The next step was, that the teams presented their business plans for the EXTEND centers for partner universities to ensure the further sustainability of the EXTEND centers. At the end of the meeting, the directors of EXTEND centers of partner universities were officially handed INTER-INSTITUTIONAL AGREEMENT ON EXTEND CENTRES NET COOPERATION. The participants also discussed the possibility for the spin-off of the Project, which can be aimed at further development of EXTEND Centres.

At the end of the day the results of working groups were presented and discussed.

WEDNESDAY, 22nd December, 2021

Morning session, 9.00 - 13.00

Safargul Odinazoda introduced the Rector of Tajik National University Prof. Khushvakhzoda Qobiljon Khushvakht. Thus, the day started with the welcome speech of Professor Khushvakhzoda Qobiljon Khushvakht, Rector of TNU. He welcomed the audience and spoke about the relevance of EXTEND project and its great contribution to the enhancement of engineering education in Russia and Tajikistan. The Rector of the TNU, Professor Khushvakhtzoda Qobiljon talked to the audience and expressed satisfaction with the achievements and implementation of project goals and objectives. At the same time, he called on taking advantage of the current opportunities and make efforts to develop the potential of universities through cooperation and implementation of joint projects.

After official Rector' Speech, the Project Coordinator Elisabeth Lazarou thanked the honorable guests for participation recapped the previous day. Participants of the Meeting discussed possibilities of future cooperation between EXTEND Centres and partner universities.

Zarina Nuridinova, Representative of NEO Tajikistan joined the meeting. She discussed with the participants of the meeting possibilities of future applications, some changes in the guidelines and other important issues concerning international projects. She spoke about the activities of the project and its achievements at the national level, the dissemination of its ideas among other universities in Tajikistan. After her speech the participants asked her questions. Zarina Nuridinova was present and observed the work of Final Management Board and Sustainability Meeting.

During the afternoon session Project members continued discussing international project cooperation with Zarina Nuridinova, Representative of NEO Tajikistan. Then the Project Coordinator discussed with the participants and controlled the work on final report preparation. Next steps for preparing further cooperation were discussed. 
